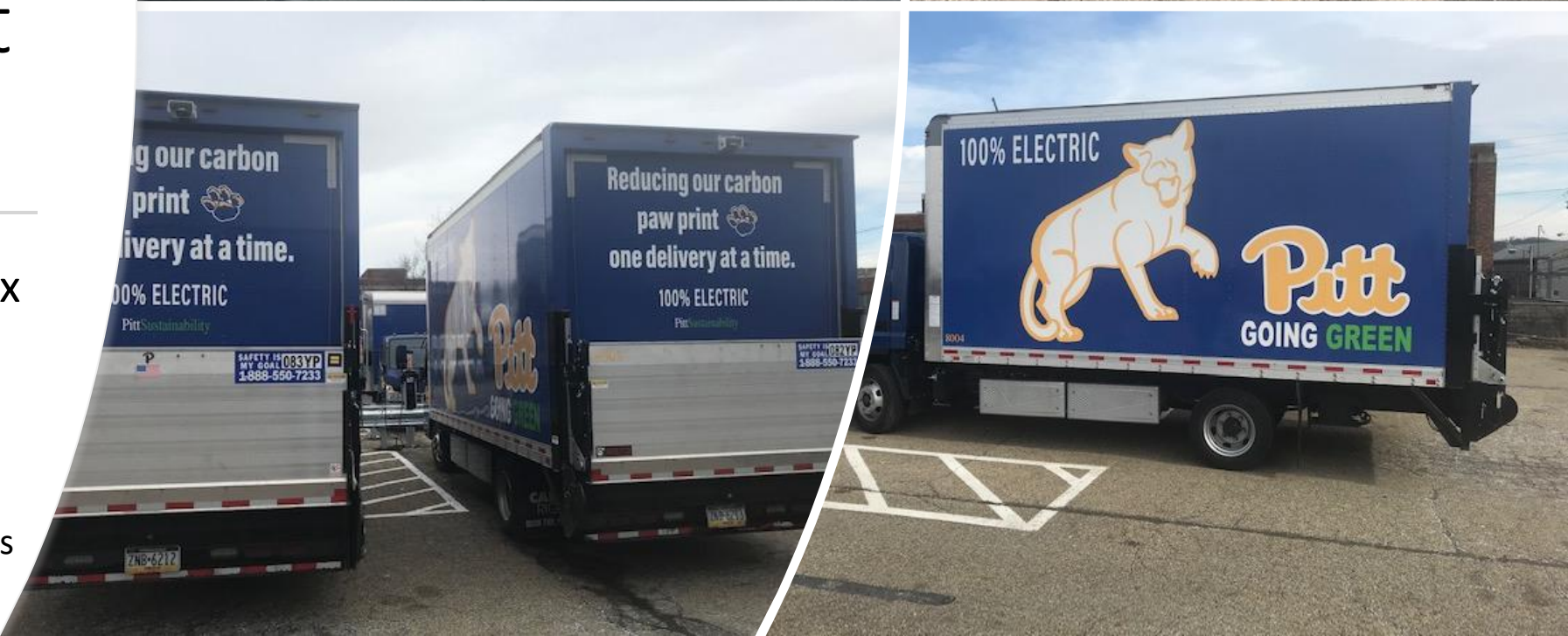

EV Charging Locations

- The Parking Office leases 22 EV charging spaces on campus. Chargers are located in the following areas:
- Posvar Garage: 8 Level II Chargers
- Soldiers & Sailors Garage: 4 Level II Chargers
- O'Hara Garage: 6 Level II Chargers
- Meade Street Lot: 4 Level II Chargers

- Prior to COVID – two electric compact cars by end of 2020
- 10 electric vehicles in 2021
- Move entire fleet to electric(300 vehicles) if models are available in 5 years
- A new agreement with [Enterprise Fleet Management](#) will provide electric and hybrid vehicles in support of the University's commitment to making the campus [carbon neutral](#) by 2037.
- Enterprise will deliver 32 new vehicles to start, including pickup trucks, cargo vans and passenger vans. Overall, it will lease 268 vehicles to Pitt. The agreement is projected to save the University \$750,000 over the next five years.
