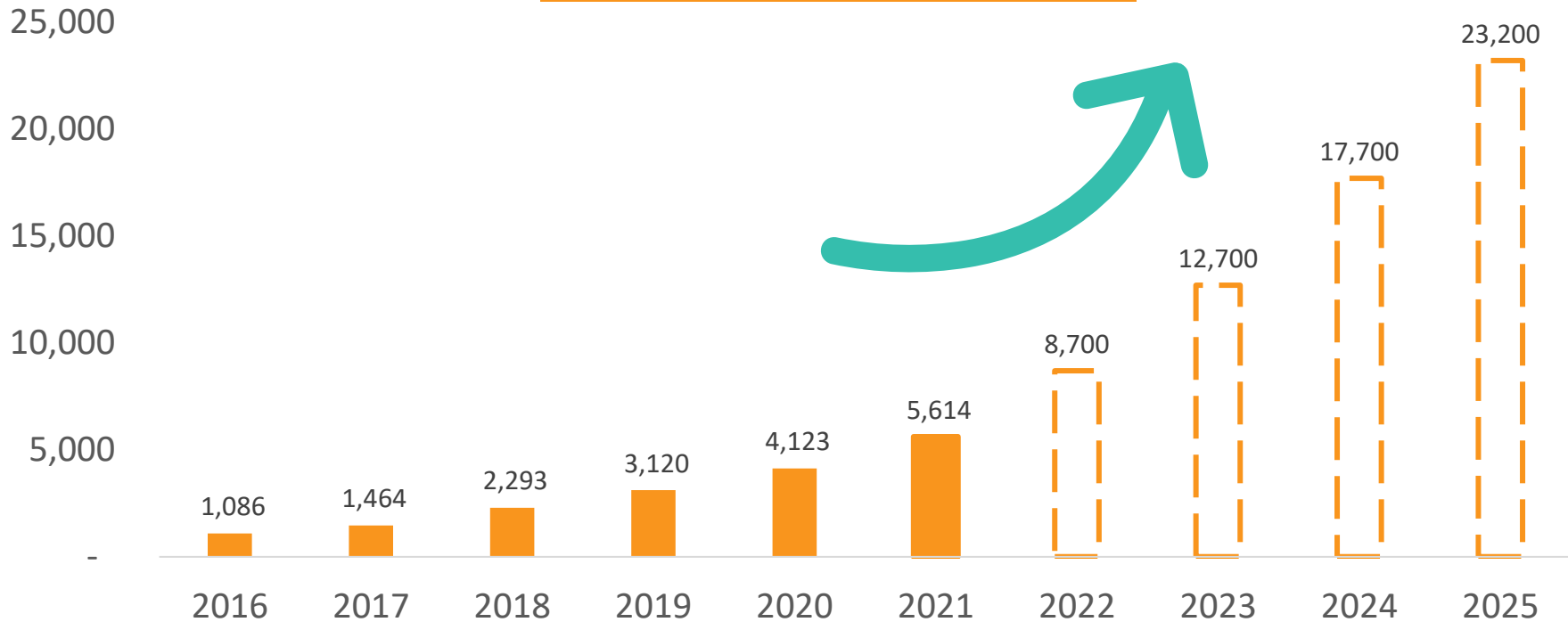

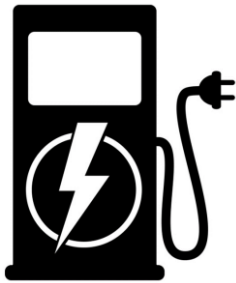

Custom Roadmap

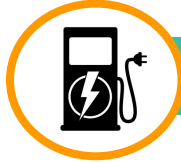
We work with customers to analyze their fleet data and provide a custom report, including:

- Environmental impact analysis



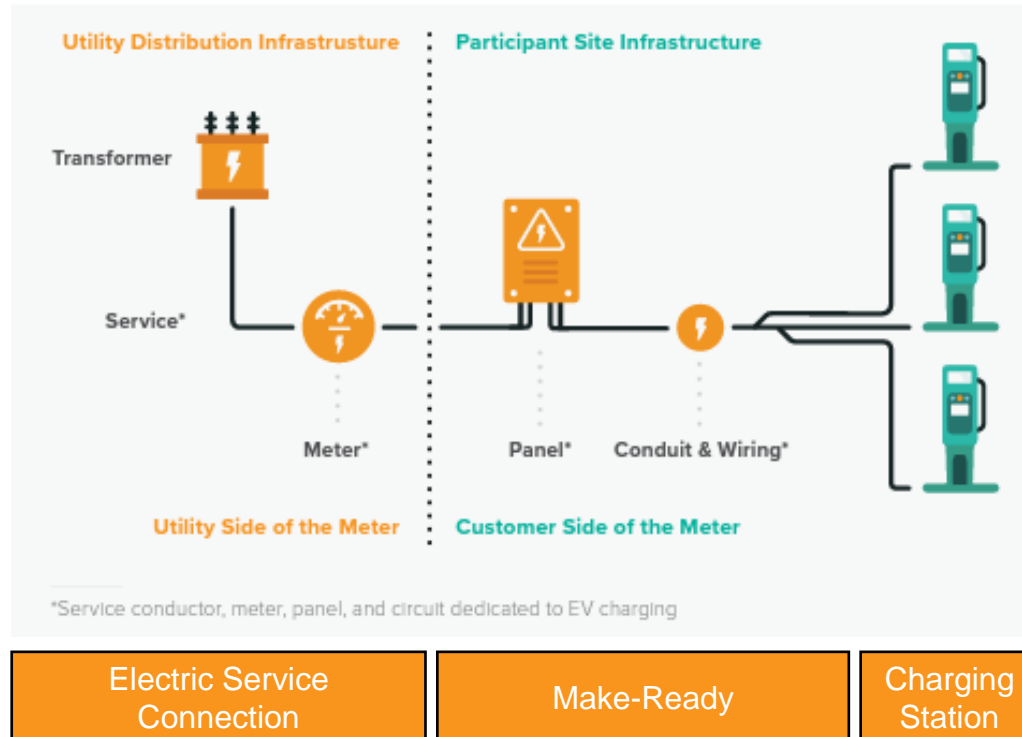

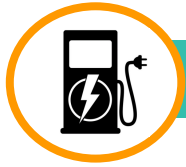

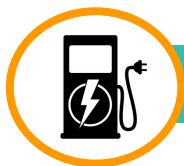
Public	Parking lots and garages open to the public.
